DIRECTOR, Office of Student Success POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Division of Student Services at Creighton University is seeking a Director for its newly established Office of Student Success. The Office of Student Success in the Division of Student Services is responsible for three major educational services, specifically: peer-to-peer learning, new student transitioning, and student success strategies. This office will be housed in the new Harper Center for Student Life & Learning beginning August 2008 complete with study rooms, conference rooms, student organization offices, and testing rooms.

The primary objective of the Director involves the oversight of all operations within the Office of Student Success including the activities of the Assistant Director. The Director reports directly to the Assistant Vice President for Student Learning while also working in concert with several key internal stakeholders across campus including, but not limited to: the Director of Creighton's Ratio Studiorum Program, the Asst. Vice President for Student Retention, the Associate Dean of Students, and the Assistant Director of Residence Life.

The successful candidate must possess a masters degree in higher education, student affairs administration, or similar area with at least 3-5 years post-masters experience. Ph.D., Ed.D. or J.D. preferred. Salary and benefits commensurate with experience and education level.

Creighton University is a private, comprehensive university in the Catholic, Jesuit tradition with approximately 6300 students. Creighton University is located near downtown Omaha, Nebraska, a growing city with metropolitan area population of 710,500, set among the rolling hills of the Missouri River Valley against an urban skyline. Omaha boasts a world-class zoo, professional and semi-professional sports teams, and a nationally recognized community theater, ballet, and symphony. Creighton University also annually co-hosts the NCAA World Series for College Baseball each June and was only one of four Division I programs last year to have teams in the NCAA playoffs in baseball, softball, women & men's basketball, women's soccer, and men's soccer.
