The Vice President for Student Affairs serves as the chief officer of the university for all matters relating to the quality of student life. Areas of responsibility include the Office of Student Development, the Counseling Center, Student Health Service, Recreational Sports, and Residence Life. The Vice President is expected to provide dynamic and effective leadership for the team of professionals who create and sustain a university environment designed to transform the lives of students through the integration of classroom and out of classroom experiences.

In addition, the Vice President is a member of the University's Leadership Council, reporting directly to the Senior Vice President and working collaboratively with other area vice presidents on matters of mutual concern and on issues of university-wide significance.

The university seeks a candidate that is strongly committed to promoting the mission of Marquette University as a Catholic, Jesuit institution; has a terminal degree, preferably in higher education or related field; and has a minimum of seven years' experience in progressively responsible leadership positions, preferably at a doctoral-level university. Other requirements include: a record of effective administration; commitment to fostering partnerships with faculty, staff, and alumni; strong personnel management, communication and planning skills; experience in budget management; and the ability to build rapport and work effectively with leadership teams. Applicants must demonstrate a proven interest in interacting extensively with students and be committed to their welfare and growth.
