

The Department of Campus Ministry of Saint Louis University announces the opening of a ten-month, full-time Campus Ministry position. The Social Justice Coordinator is responsible for fostering students' faith formation, education, and direct service / action surrounding issues of peace and social justice. This position provides students with opportunities to develop an ever-deepening understanding of the relationship between faith and social justice.

Some of the job duties include planning and facilitating the Urban Plunge retreat, direct service, immersion trips to domestic and international locations, SOA vigil, and Pax Christi.

This position requires an evening work schedule and some weekends.

Preference will be given to candidates possessing an M.A. in Theology or related field, plus some pastoral experience. Other qualifications include: strong organizational skills, knowledge of Ignatian spirituality, and the ability to work with students, staff and faculty in a Jesuit educational system.
