The Department of Campus Ministry of Saint Louis University announces the opening of a ten-month, full-time Campus Ministry position. In this position, the campus minister as Liturgy Coordinator has primary responsibility for supervising the department's weekly liturgies and other devotional activities, as well as the University's special liturgies. In addition, this campus minister serves as Chaplain to the upperclass students of Micah House, a service learning program. Ability to live in the Micah House residence hall is desirable, although negotiable.

Worship is central to the faith community of Saint Louis University. The Liturgy coordinator is assisted by a Coordinator of Liturgical Music and a large number of presiders and student liturgical ministers. An essential strength of this minister will be someone with strong organizational skills and an ability to communicate with students, faculty, administration and clergy. In addition to the above duties, this minister also staffs retreats and mission trips. The position requires an evening work schedule and some weekends.

Preference will be given to candidates possessing an M.A. in theology or related field, plus some pastoral experience. Other desired qualifications include: knowledge of Ignatian spirituality, and proven ability to work with students, staff and faculty in a Jesuit educational system.
